School Uniform Requirements continued

Jewellery:	For safety reasons the only items of jewellery permitted are a watch and small stud earrings - no more than <u>one</u> stud per ear. Body piercings are forbidden. No jewellery is allowed for PE lessons.	
School Bag:	A sturdy waterproof bag is required that is large enough for books and equipment to be carried in.	
Hair:	Long hair must be tied back in practical lessons. No extreme hairstyles, unnatural colours, multi-colours, patterns or logos are permitted.	
Make Up / Nail Varnish:	Make up must be discreet. Nail varnish / false nails are <u>not</u> permitted in school.	
Earphones/ headphones	These are not part of the school uniform and should not be worn in school.	
Headscarves:	If these are worn for religious or cultural reasons they should be plain and dark in colour.	
Badges:	Only school and charity badges may be worn.	
Tattoos	These are not permitted in school.
