Tringa (Year 7) for excellent participation in form time including creating a fair way to vote for school council reps and being kind and helpful.

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

Migena (Year 11) for helping another student regulate in Drama so the work could continue. She was very kind and mature about the whole thing.


Bartosz (Year 11) for creating such an amazing in depth revision guide for himself for science, and he spends time before tutor time working through it and helping his peers understand it also.
